Student Seating Priority System

How it Works...

Student seat selection will be determined by academic level and years of purchase. The purpose of this system is to permit the Division of Intercollegiate Athletics to give higher priority to students with more seniority at the University and to express its appreciation to students with a higher number of years of season ticket purchases.

- To receive group seating (for season tickets ONLY), all order forms MUST BE SUBMITTED TOGETHER.
- To receive years of purchase points for Orange Krush membership, YOU MUST INDICATE THE MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION ON THE ORDER FORM.

Point Breakdown

Category	Points	Description
Freshman (0-30 hrs)	1 point	For each academic level earned based upon official UIUC records.
Sophomore (31-60 hrs)	2 points	
Junior (61-90 hrs)	3 points	
Senior (91-120 hrs)	4 points	
Graduate Student	5 points	
Split Season Packages	2 points	For each year as a split season ticket holder.
Season Tickets	3 points	For each year as a season ticket holder or Orange Krush member.

Examples for Tallying Points...

Student "A"

Has earned zero hours credit (0-30 hrs) = 1 point
 Has never purchased previously (3 points x 0 years) = 0 points
 TOTAL POINTS = 1 point

Student "B"

Has earned 37 hours credit (31-60 hrs) = 2 points
 Has purchased one year previously (3 points x 1 year) = 3 points
 TOTAL POINTS = 5 points

Student "C"

Has earned 102 hours credit (91-120 hrs) = 4 points
 Has purchased three years previously (3 points x 3 years) = 9 points
 TOTAL POINTS = 13 points

Student "D"

Has earned 72 hours credit (61-90 hrs) = 3 points
 Has purchased two years previously (3 points x 2 years) = 6 points
 TOTAL POINTS = 9 points

Important Notes...

- All points are based upon an individual's official status at the University of Illinois as of September 2009.
- The system is designed as a guideline for priority seating. All rights to assign exact locations rest with the Division of Intercollegiate Athletics.
- The priority privilege is not transferable.
- Season ticket group (20 or less) orders should be submitted together and so indicated on each. Each group member must be present when the order is placed. Please understand that the group priority will be based on the average points of the individual members in that group. Groups over 20 will **NOT** be accepted.
- Each student may order one (1) ticket and must do so in person. Married students may order two (2); if married, spouse must present a spouse ID card (available at IUB).
- **Receipt of order does NOT guarantee tickets.**
- **Student season ticket holders are REQUIRED to present their student ID when entering the Assembly Hall.**

IN THE EVENT THAT SEASON TICKET SALES EXCEED THE AVAILABLE ALLOTMENT, THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES WILL BE UTILIZED:

- The point system will be applied with tickets assigned from highest to lowest point totals.
- In the event that orders exceed available tickets and there is a tie for the lowest eligible point total, a lottery will be used to determine who is eligible to receive the remaining tickets.
- If necessary, results of the lottery will be communicated via email on October 7, 2009.

Student Ticket Prices...

- Season tickets are \$134.00 and include only the games that are held when classes are in session (12 games).
- Students do NOT pay for, nor do they receive, tickets during semester break.
- Break game tickets will be available for purchase at \$11.00 each and will be allocated based on priority points and will not be located in the same seat as your student season ticket.

Ticket Pick-Up...

- Distribution of student season tickets will begin at 9:00 a.m. on **Monday, October 19, 2009** at the Assembly Hall North Box Office.
- Each student is required to pick-up his/her own ticket and present a valid 2009/10 I-Card.
